Lancaster, PA – April 15, 2011 - [Paul Davis Restoration and Remodeling](http://www.pdr-usa.net) has moved to a new location at 1704 Hempstead Road in Lancaster, Pa. The company was formerly located at 1817 Colonial Village Lane in Lancaster. According to Steve Rotay, Paul Davis office owner, the new space includes 50,000 square feet of space in one of Central Pennsylvania's most prestigious corporate centers. The new office is centrally located to serve customers in Adams, Berks, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Lancaster, Lebanon, and York.

Rotay has leased and customized the new space with office, sales and administrative areas, a full-service showroom and design center, and a state-of-the-art classroom for continuing education and training courses. The warehouse and contents processing facility includes climate-controlled storage for the contents of approximately 20 homes. The office will employ members of the company's long-time staff and expects to hire for new positions including an electronics specialist, administration and sales professionals, project managers, a contents manager and mitigation manager.

"We moved into our previous facility only two years ago. That building was twice the size of the first building. Due to our tremendous growth in sales, capability and employees, we have decided to expand into a much larger facility," said Rotay.

The new location will feature some of the latest equipment available in the restoration industry including the patented Esporta Wash System which restores damaged contents that are typically unsalvageable and thrown out including electronics, art, hard and soft contents. The office is also equipped with technologies for deodorizing, and upholstery and rug cleaning, to name a few.

"Business professionalism and industry knowledge are important factors that contribute to our success at Paul Davis," said Rotay. "We are committed to serving our community and its residents by providing exceptional customer service. We help people through some of the most difficult times of their lives through our restoration work and our ongoing community service activities."
