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Paul Davis Restoration donates restoration services to The Eichholtz School Apartments

New, more secure doors were also installed. Value of the project was estimated at \$25,000.

Michael Carper, President of HDC, said, "I'm grateful that Paul Davis Restoration donated their time and money to make repairs and renovations that are sorely needed and that we have not been able to afford. Residents in those ten apartments will have a better quality of life."
