Paul Davis Restoration offices attend and sponsor the New Jersey State Firefighter's Mutual Benevolent Association's 4th Annual Firefighters Land and Sea Holiday

Union, NJ – October 20, 2011- Patrick Wildridge and Bill Elliott, Paul Davis Restoration office owners in Cranbury and Hainesport, respectively, recently attended and sponsored the 4th Annual Firefighters Land and Sea Holiday (F.L.A.S.H) and golf event hosted by the New Jersey State Firefighter's Mutual Benevolent Association (NJFMBA). From October 5 – 9, the fundraiser was held at Ocean Creek Resort in Myrtle Beach, SC and raised \$62,000 for Eden Autism Services in Princeton and Autism New Jersey in Ewing. The organization also educates residents in the prevention, detection and extinguishment of fires, and provides public safety programs in New Jersey.
