### **Owner of Paul Davis Restoration & Remodeling of Central Massachusetts receives top honors**

More than 100 local trades people and volunteers helped Stone and his staff during the three day project in November 2007.

"Molly Bish was abducted on June 27, 2000 from Comins Pond in Warren where she worked as a lifeguard. Molly was 16 years old at the time of her abduction. The efforts of law enforcement, the media and community in the search for Molly were unprecedented. The extensive search for Molly was the largest and most costly of its kind in Massachusetts history. The search came to its end on June 9, 2003, just three years and just five miles from her family home with the discovery of Molly's remains," said Stone.

"We are dedicated to helping John and Magi Bish. I cannot begin to tell you how proud we are to accept the company's GEM award for the work we do for the Bish family and their tireless efforts to make our children safer," said Stone.
